Young Players - Code of Conduct

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

When playing football, I will:

- ❖ Always play to the best of my ability
- ❖ Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- ❖ Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee, my coaches/managers and all spectators
- ❖ Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- ❖ Shake hands with the other team and referee before and at the end of the game
- ❖ Listen and respond to what my coaches/managers tells me
- ❖ Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- ❖ Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee, team coaches/managers or spectators
- ❖ Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- ❖ Be dropped or substituted
- ❖ Be suspended from training
- ❖ Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- ❖ My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- ❖ The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.
